Proposal Submission Deadline: 29 September 2025

***ANNUAL REVIEW OF COMPARATIVE AND
INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION 2025***
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Editor

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We invite chapter proposals that explore major developments, current trends, and future directions in the field of comparative and international education. Review chapter proposals should (a) be 1000 word maximum summaries, (b) identify the preferred contribution section (see A-D below), and (c) deal explicitly with as many of the following as applicable: (1) a clear statement of the topic being reviewed; (2) relevant social, economic, political, or historical context of topic; (3) key unresolved questions; (4) possible future research directions; (5) the broader significance or relevance of the proposed review chapter to comparative and international education research or practice; and (6) a representative reference list (does not add to proposal word count).

Review chapter proposals are invited for the following sections:

- A. **Conceptual and Methodological Developments**: addressing how theoretical frameworks and research methodologies frame comparative and international education research and practice
- B. **Research-to-Practice**: focusing on the translation of comparative and international education research into practical applications and situations in educational systems worldwide
- C. **Area Studies and Regional Developments**: providing insights into how unique social, cultural, political, and economic contexts in different regions impact education, and what this means for the field of comparative and international education
- D. **Diversification of the Field**: exploring emerging topics and issues that have been underexplored or that show significant potential within the field of comparative and international education

Unlike empirical research articles, which typically involve collecting and analyzing new data, *review chapters focus on synthesizing existing literature. They provide a comprehensive overview of the state of knowledge in specific areas, offering critical evaluations of multiple studies, and identifying key unresolved questions and future research directions.* These chapters are more reflective and integrative in nature, serving as a foundation for setting research agendas and guiding future inquiries.
